We recently started implementing music in our youth exchanges and training courses. We have found that music connects our participants into a group easier, and helps them listen to each other and co-create more freely and openly. We are interested in workshops that foster connections like that.

We want to explore musical workshop activities suitable for youth work and education, and the market of practitioners who carry them out.

We are looking for youth workers who will attend the workshops at the kick-off event and give feedback in order to mold them into a form that is most suitable for youth work and education.

The workshops will be carried out by musicians, from Slovenia and abroad.
